What is a mercury Thermometer Exchange?

- A half-day event at the hospital at which staff and visitors turn in mercury fever thermometers from home and, in return, receive a complimentary non-mercury thermometer or voucher for an alternative
- •These events educate staff and patients about the environmental and public health impacts of mercury, help reduce accidental thermometer breakage or improper disposal, and empower people to improve the environment
