




"The dictionary catalog of the Slavonic Collection of the Reference Department, The New York Public Library, includes approximately 508,788 entries for works in the Lettish, Lithuanian, and Slavonic languages including all translations from Balto-Slavonic belles-lettres, and all works in any non-Balto-Slavonic language on Balto-Slavonic linguistics or belles-lettres. The Slavonic Collection numbers roughly 130,000 volumes and is one of the three major Slavic libraries in the United States. The Slavonic Collection, and hence its catalog, is strong in periodicals and public documents, imaginative literature in all its forms, history, the social sciences, and mathematics, chemistry and physics. The catalog contains many analytics and is notable for the number of references to periodical articles, not only in the Balto-Slavonic, but also in western languages."

The 508,788 cards in this Catalog have been reproduced by offset with 21 cards per 10" x 14" page. Permalife paper, developed by W. J. Barrow under a grant from the Council on Library Resources, was used. The 26 volumes are oversewn and bound in Class A Library Binding.

## ***Dictionary Catalog of the Cincinnati Library of the HEBREW UNION COLLEGE—JEWISH INSTITUTE OF RELIGION***
