PERIODICALS. UMI has modern American, English, and foreign periodicals on microfilm. In addition, special collections include English literary periodicals from the 17th, 18th, and 19th centuries. And early American periodicals from 1741 to 1850.

DOCTORAL DISSERTATIONS. UMI has 70,000 doctoral dissertations from 150 universities covering mathematics, science, social sciences, and humanities. Additional dissertations are being abstracted in *Dissertation Abstracts* at a rate of more than 10,000 every year.

OUT-OF-PRINT BOOKS. UMI has more than 10,000 out-of-print, modern books stored on microfilm and especially prepared for xerographic reproduction. These and most other out-of-print books are available for as little as 3½ cents a page.

UNDERGRADUATE SHEFLIST. UMI has a list of the 57,000 books in the University of Michigan undergraduate library. This list is available on microfilm, file cards and in bound volumes. UMI also has many of the out-of-print books on this list.

RUSSIAN LANGUAGE BOOKS. UMI has over 2000 books in the Slavic languages. Most of these books are now out of print. You can get xerographic copies from UMI.

EARLY ENGLISH BOOKS. UMI has most of the books listed in the Polard & Redgrave and Wing catalogs. These books were published in Great Britain between 1475 and 1700.

EARLY AMERICAN BOOKS. UMI has an American Culture series that begins with the Columbus letter and includes 6000 selected books published through 1876.

OTHER. UMI also has newspapers, government documents, collections on drama, the theatre, music, painting, and world cultures.



WE ARE PLEASED to announce the publication of this important index. The following description was provided by Mr. Adolf K. Placzek, Avery Librarian, Columbia University:

This index is the most comprehensive one in existence in the field of architecture in its widest sense, including all the decorative arts, interior decoration, furniture, archaeology, and, importantly, city planning and housing. It was begun systematically in 1934. Since then, the major American architectural periodicals (*American Architect*, *Architectural Forum*, *Architectural Record*, *Progressive Architecture*) have been back-indexed to their beginnings; a detailed record of American architecture and architects is, therefore, one of the strongest features of the Index. A selective back-indexing of European magazines was likewise pursued. At present most architectural magazines (excluding those in non-western alphabets) are indexed, including South American, French, Swiss, German, Italian, Spanish, Belgian, Dutch, and Scandinavian magazines. The *Index* not only excels in coverage of current American material, but also of foreign sources not indexed elsewhere.

Whenever an architect is mentioned, an entry is made under his name. Thus an imposing list of individual architects has been built up through the years, which includes many barely known and hard-to-track names.

While inevitable shifts of emphasis and personnel will be apparent, basic procedures and thorough indexing activities have been maintained through the years, and the *Avery Index to Architectural Periodicals* represents a unique record of architecture and the many activities related to it.

The 265,000 cards in this index have been reproduced by offset on Permalife paper with about 33 cards per 10" x 14" page. The 12 volumes are bound in Class A library binding.

Periodic supplements to this index will be issued in volumes of about 10,000 entries each.
