**Great Britain. Cabinet Office.
Cabinet Minutes and Memoranda,
1916-1939.**

Kraus-Thomson, in conjunction with Her Majesty's Stationery Office, has undertaken the micropublication of the British Cabinet Minutes and Memoranda. This 35mm microfilm program makes widely available a complete record of the deliberations of the British Cabinet from 1916, when a system to preserve such records was inaugurated, through September 1939. The program includes the Cabinets of Lloyd George, Bonar Law, Stanley Baldwin, Ramsay MacDonald, and Neville Chamberlain.

The Cabinet records are divided into two categories, CAB 23 and CAB 24. CAB 23, the Minutes (or "Conclusions") of the Cabinet meetings, contains the agenda of each meeting, the names of the Cabinet officers present, and lists and descriptions of documents presented for evaluation and discussion, as well as the records of the meetings themselves. CAB 24, the Memoranda (or "Cabinet Papers"), consists of the various documents presented at each Cabinet meeting. Originally highly confidential, many of these are detailed reports that were prepared for the study and analysis of the topics under discussion. In addition the Memoranda contain correspondence and dispatches among the political leaders or representatives of other nations, and among representatives of the Crown throughout the world.

Included in the program are subject indices to both CAB 23 and CAB 24, and a Bibliographical/Chronological Guide which enables the researcher to locate specific Cabinet documents within the microfilm collection.
