These use cases describe how XSEDE personnel and community members need to manage and use group definitions. In its simplest form, a group definition is *a list of people* that needs to be maintained and used for some ongoing purpose. These use cases are derived from a project-wide user needs study conducted in early 2017 by the XSEDE Community Infrastructure (XCI) team's Requirements Analysis and Capability Delivery (RACD) activity. The use cases describe what is needed by XSEDE stakeholders, <u>not</u> what is easily accomplished using the current XSEDE system. This will be used as a basis for further system engineering activities.
